Said road was adopted as a county road on February 29, 1929. County Commissioners Journal 2, page 548. The Commissioners received the petition to vacate from County Planner John Marks who then went over the packet of information, which includes the Petition, an aerial photo of the road and the Montana Codes Annotated regarding the abandonment of roads. The commissioners and John will plan a site visit for investigation purposes prior to the public hearing to be noticed and scheduled on the May 21, 2013 agenda, with a Resolution prepared for abandonment on that same agenda.
