Resolution # 849

**Resolution to Establish Capital Improvement
Fund for County Infrastructure Projects**

WHEREAS, the County Commissioners of Rosebud County want to establish a capital improvement fund for county infrastructure projects;

WHEREAS, the County Commissioners would like to use the funds for capital improvements in excess of \$100,000.00. These improvements may be infrastructure repairs or new construction;

WHEREAS, provisions of section 7-6-616 MCA authorizes a;

- (1) A county, municipal, or special district governing body to establish a capital improvement fund for the replacement, improvement, and acquisition of property, facilities, or equipment that costs in excess of \$5,000.00 and that has a life expectancy of 5 years or more.
- (2) A capital improvement fund must be formally adopted by the county, municipal, or special district governing body.
- (3) The capital improvement fund may receive money from any source, including funds that have been allocated in any year but have not been expended or encumbered by the end of the fiscal year.
- (4) Money in the capital improvement fund must be invested as provided by law, and interest and income from the investment of the capital improvement fund must be credited to the fund.

WHEREAS, the County Commissioners would like to transfer \$3,000,000.00 from federal mineral royalty money fund to the capital improvement fund for county infrastructure projects;

WHEREAS, the County Commissioners agree to annually put a minimum of 25% of the federal mineral royalty monies received into the capital improvement fund;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners of Rosebud County formally adopt a capital improvement fund for county infrastructure projects.
