RESOLUTION # 851

RESOLUTION TO DECLARE COUNTY DISASTER AREA

WHEREAS; Flooding has caused severe damage to roads, bridges, and public and private buildings within the County on May 23rd, 2011, and;

WHEREAS; restoration of these facilities is essential to ensure the health, safety and welfare of residents of the County; and

WHEREAS; the County has committed all available resources, taken all possible action to combat and to alleviate the situation and local resources are not adequate to cope with the situation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Commissioners that a disaster is hereby declared pursuant to Section 10-3-(402 or 403), MCA, because expenditures for repair and damaged facilities will be beyond the financial capability of the County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that there shall be appropriated immediately to that Emergency Fund Number 2260 an amount equivalent to two (2) mills on the taxable valuation of the County outside the incorporated municipalities, pursuant to Section 10-3-405, MCA. Said two (2) mills will be levied during fiscal year 2012 and be utilized for restoring services and repairing facilities damaged by the flooding.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that copies of this resolution be filed with the County Clerk and Recorder, County Assessor and the Montana Disaster and Emergency Services Division in Helena.
